## ***Construction Specification 2-- Clearing and Grubbing***

### **1. Scope**

The work consists of clearing and grubbing and disposal of trees, snags, logs, brush, stumps, shrubs, and rubbish from the ditch corridor.

### **2. Clearing and grubbing**

Trees, snags, logs, brush and stumps in the existing ditch corridor that obstruct the installation of the proposed pipeline or movement of equipment and materials may be cut and disposed of in a manner and at locations approved by the Engineer or Owner. Only trees, logs, snags, logs, brush and stumps within five feet of the centerline of the proposed pipeline alignment may be removed. The contractor is responsible for complying with all local rules and regulations and the payment of any and all fees that may result from disposal at locations away from the project site.

### **3. Measurement and payment**

Payment for clearing and grubbing is based on the linear foot of ditch corridor cleared. The sum of such payments shall constitute full compensation for clearing and grubbing (including the clearing and grubbing of smaller trees, stumps, snags, logs, brush, shrubs, and roots), applicable permits and associated fees, and rubbish removal. Such payment shall constitute full compensation for all labor, equipment, tools, and all other items necessary and incidental to the completion of the work.
